



PRODUCTS ON PLATFORMS

Essex products are on board nearly every US fighter, trainer, bomber, and cargo aircraft currently in operation worldwide. An industry leader in military fighter aircraft HMI (human-machine interface) controls, Essex has also had several successful launches of ground combat vehicle and rotor-wing aircraft controls including collective and cyclic grips, tail rotor pedal assemblies, and cockpit control panels. Since 1947, the company has continued to work with leading Aerospace and Defense OEMs to serve advanced aircraft platforms.

Essex Aircraft Components meet stringent requirements within the aircraft subsystems including fuel, hydraulic, pneumatic, and oxygen. Our precision-machined products include valves, flame arrestors, dampeners, bulkheads, dash panels, struts, bell cranks, linkages, and hundreds of other mechanical and electromechanical components and assemblies.

This is only possible with the dedicated people supporting these product lines. The aerospace industry requires high precision with tight tolerances. Every piece that touches their hands directly impacts the safety of another human being. Whether that is the person piloting the air or ground vehicle, the person on a transport aircraft, or the mechanics who work on the systems, it all matters.
